# Key ACT Insights 2019


Kids Helpline gives children and young people support anytime and for any reason. It is designed to play complex and multifaceted roles in the ACT mental health system, including as a front door to services and support, as well as roles in prevention, soft entry, safety net and case management. While Kids Helpline is able to help many children and young people, 48% of contacts to Kids Helpline from the ACT were not able to be answered in 2019.


